AIM HIGH: Soaring with the Tuskegee Airmen

Aim High: Soaring with the Tuskegee Airmen makes its debut in May at Amazement Square. Created by Children's Museum of Pittsburgh in partnership with Hosanna House. A² is the second museum in the country to show this exhibition!

This interactive exhibition invites visitors to explore the multiple aspects of aviation, from the rich history of the Tuskegee Airmen to 21st century STEM concepts. Inspired by the tools and tasks related to flying and aeronautics, the interactive experiences mix real artifacts with hands-on play. Visitors of all ages will be able to imagine themselves in the role of the aviators, inspired by the past and dream of the future.

In partnership with the Legacy Museum of African American History and the Anne Spencer House and Garden Museum, complementary programming will take place throughout the summer. Check out our website to learn more!
